



Covid Cases As you will be aware we have had a challenging week. We have had several cases over the last few days with some children returning to school and some children still isolating at home. We have had to put a couple of control measures back in place such as not all mixing in the hall for assembly and lunchtime, not mixing at playtimes and staying in our class 'bubbles' to reduce the chance of transmission. These will hopefully be short term measures whilst we ride out this surge in infections however after seeking further guidance from Public Health England, whilst there are still live cases in school these measures will remain in place.
