

# THE VIKINGS ARE COMING!



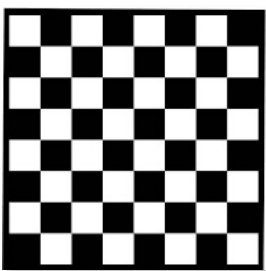
