Church Visit Ribble Class had a great trip to Christ Church yesterday to learn about Christian places of worship. Thank you to Mrs Evans for arranging it!



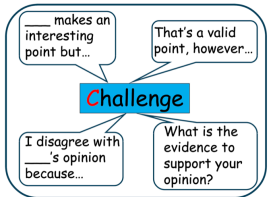
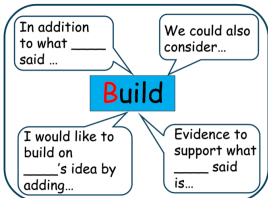
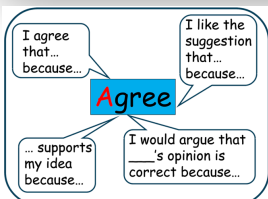
Developing Oracy One of our areas of focus this school year is to develop oracy skills and the art of conversation in our children. In order to do so, we are helping them by giving them strategies to
