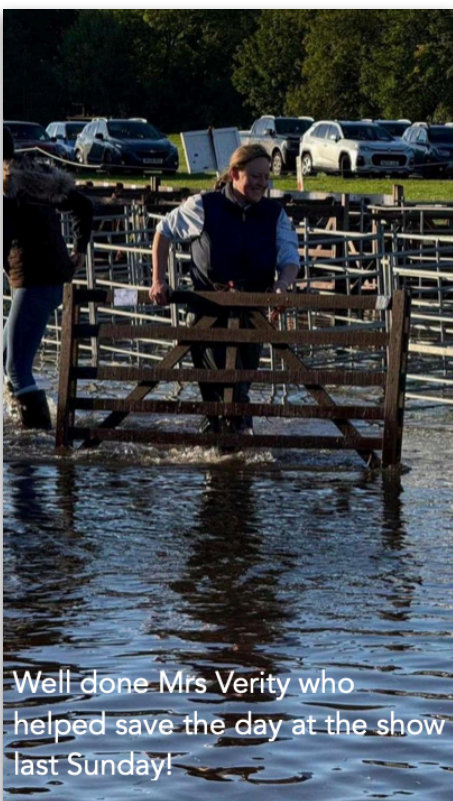
**PTFA AGM** Thank you to those parents who attended the AGM this week. It was nice to see some new faces! Here's to a successful year!

Head to National Trust Brimham Rocks, Summerbridge, HG3 4DW, and learn how to make a traditional broom. Brooms are just £7.50 each and reuse the birch felled by the rangers during essential moorland conservation work.
