Below are a few details of what is expected from a trustee.

For a PTA that is registered as a charity, a trustee is one of the people legally responsible for running the charity and making sure it operates properly.

Trustees typically:

- Make sure PTA funds are used only for the charity's purposes (supporting the school and pupils).
- Oversee finances, budgets, and spending decisions.
- Ensure the PTA follows the rules in its governing document (constitution).
- Make sure the charity complies with requirements from the Charity Commission for England and Wales.
- Manage risks and safeguard the charity's assets.
- Act in the charity's best interests rather than for personal benefit.
- Approve annual accounts and reports.
- Trustees don't have to do all the day-to-day fundraising or event organisation themselves, but they are responsible for ensuring those activities are properly managed.
